## **RULES**

1. No business cheques accepted.
2. Please send a large (c5) SAE for return numbers.
3. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they have entered the correct class and that any clash of classes is not the shows responsibility, classes will not be held up.
4. Entries are accepted on the understanding that exhibitors have read the rules and agree to abide by the various society rules and the rules of the show.
5. All stallions must have a current stallion licence. Exhibitors may be asked to produce this licence in the ring or prior to entry. All Stallions competing in NPS classes MUST wear a stallion bridle marker.
6. Mares with foals must be four years or over. Three year old fillies with foals are not eligible to enter.
7. All foals must be at least three weeks old on show day and accompany their dam in the ring.
8. Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed immediately without question at the request of a judge, steward or any show official.
9. Any person wishing to lodge a protest must do so in writing and at the same time deposit the sum of £50 with the Show Secretary. If on investigation by the show committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show.
10. The decision of the judge is final. Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept the decision of Judges who have the power to withhold any prize for the lack of competition in any class.
11. The National Pony Society Area 27 committee nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising out of this show.
12. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their animal correctly insured.
13. Please note that spurs are NOT allowed in NPS classes.
14. Public Liability Insurance, which is strongly recommended, is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
15. Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday in the current year to compete in any class at this show. A competitor's age will be taken from the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current season.
16. The organisers and Show Committee will take any necessary precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of persons on the Show ground. It is a condition of entry that all

persons will act on any instructions given to them by the show committee, in so far that it can affect the health and safety of all. All competitors must take due regard to Section 7 of the Health and Safety Act and have due regard for the safety of others. The committee of the NPS Area 27 accept no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the show ground.

17. The committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide any classes should entries so warrant. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving a reason.
18. An exhibitor may not exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased or purchased by the judge, their immediate family or their employer.
19. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS) EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. The most recent updates to the list are the addition fo SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standards is accepted to the list; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard is also accepted to the list.
20. We advise that all competitors consider vaccinating for equine influenza. Annual Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes
21. May we remind all members to ensure they are fully conversant with the 2022 rules changes which are highlighted in bold in the rule book.
22. **No children under the age of 5 may compete in in-hand classes.**

23. **NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds:**

These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS .Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective mountain and Moorland Stud Books. Part-breds are not eligible.

Qualifying round for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Life or Qualifying** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Three Counties Showground Malvern from **3rd - 5th August 2022.**

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no further than 3<sup>rd</sup> place. .

**24. NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds:**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, **International or Sports Pony Section of the BRPSB**, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books Part-breds are **not** eligible **unless** they are registered in **the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB**. Ponies must be plaited.

Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Life or Qualifying** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show Three Counties Showground Malvern from **3rd - 5th August 2022**.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member, and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Judges and/or stewards will check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards.

**25. NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a **Life or Qualifying** Member of the NPS. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show Three Counties Show ground Malvern from **3rd - 5th August 2022**.

**26. NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championships**

Riders of Home Produced Ponies (see definition in NPS Rules Book) can wear a white armband in classes where this is indicated. These ponies if owned by NPS Life or Qualifying members are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

### **NPS / Talent Forte Recruitment British Isles Area Supreme Flat Ridden Championship (BI-R)**

There are no specific registration criteria for ponies.
